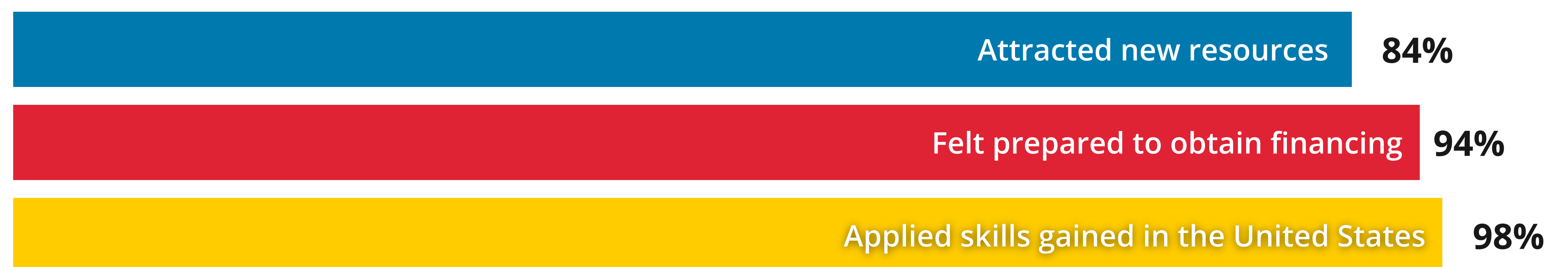

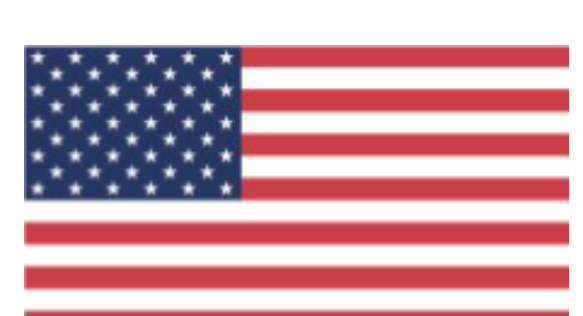

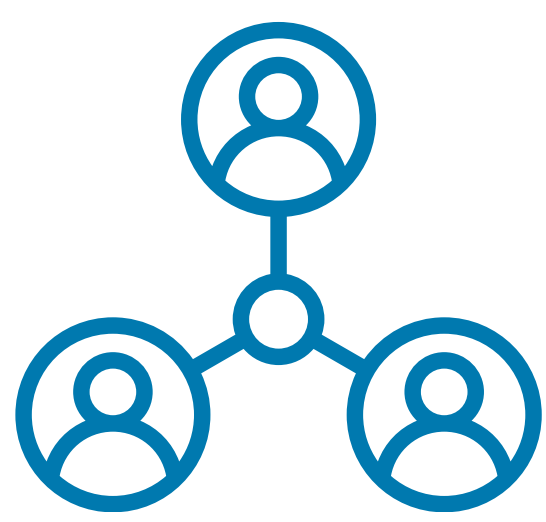

THE THREE PILLARS OF YLAI



The YLAI Fellowship Program is an annual exchange program for 280 young business and social entrepreneurs from 37 countries across Latin America, the Caribbean, and Canada, who are matched with businesses and organizations across the United States. In addition to entrepreneurial leadership training, fellows build new skills, share best practices, and forge commercial ties. YLAI alumni also have access to Outbound Exchanges, small grants, resources and events, as well as to exclusive opportunities offered by the U.S. Department of State on alumni.state.gov.



The YLAI Network is a virtual community of 55,000+ entrepreneurship-minded members from across the Americas. Network members engage with curated leadership and business development resources that highlight innovative U.S. models, policy-focused campaigns, and networking opportunities.
